



## Ride the Carousel Circuit 2008 Guide

**C**ollect a special “I Rode the Carousel” card from each of the six Greater Binghamton carousels after you have completed your ride. They are available at each carousel site throughout the summer. Each carousel has an individual card color.

**A**fter you have collected all six (you need only **ONE** card from each site) have your cards validated at any of the carousel park sites and receive a commemorative “I Rode the Carousel Circuit” button.

**R**emember when you are at Recreation Park to view the exhibit panels that are displayed inside the carousel enclosure. They give a brief overview of the special history of our carousels.

**O**perating hours for the carousels are listed in the carousel brochure which is available at the Roberson Museum & Binghamton Visitor Center (607) 772-0660, the Greater Binghamton Chamber of Commerce (607) 772-8863, the Endicott Visitor Center (607) 757-5355 and at each of the six carousel sites.

**U**nique carousel animals exist on our special collection of local carousels. Always check with individual parks if you are planning a special group trip or have any questions about the park facilities.

**S**easonal hours of operation sometimes change so publications may not be accurate. Inclement weather and mechanical problems can sometimes cause temporary closures. If this occurs and you are unable to return at a later time, your visit will be honored by the park directly or by calling one of the telephone numbers below.

**E**ach of the six carousel rides continue to be offered to the public **FREE** of charge since their donation by the great industrial benefactor, George F. Johnson. The Binghamton & Endicott Visitor Centers are also FREE.....just like our carousels!
